

Code of Conduct - MILAN 2026

Milan is an annual cultural SRM-KTR fest, where students from different institutions come together to take part in competitions based on talent and skill. This fest celebrates diversity, creativity, and skill.

All participants, attendees, organisers, and visitors are expected to abide by the following Code of Conduct, so as to guarantee a safe and fun experience for all.

Overall Conduct

- Every participant should conduct themselves in a responsible, polite, and sporting manner at all times.
- Participants should abide by the guidelines provided by the university administration and organising committee and violation will lead to consequences.

Inclusivity and Respect

- Discriminating or harassing someone based on their gender, caste, religion, region, language, disability, or sexual orientation will be met with serious disciplinary actions.
- Any form of intimidation, bullying, physical violence, or verbal abuse will be met with immediate disciplinary action and disqualification from the competition.
- Personal boundaries and consent must always be respected, particularly at busy events like DJ parties and concerts.

Events and Competitions

- Each event has its own set of rules and regulations, which must be followed.
- Unfair practices, including plagiarism and cheating, may result in disqualification.
- The rulings of the judges shall be final and binding.

Pro Shows (DJ nights and concerts)

- It is forbidden to push, vandalise, invade a stage, damage sound or lighting equipment.
- Smoking, narcotics, alcohol, and all other illegal substances are strictly prohibited on campus and will be met with legal consequences if found in possession.

Campus Cleanliness and Property

- Any harm to the university's property or event space will be taken seriously and will result in penalties or legal action.

- Participants are encouraged to keep the space clean and accessible to all, by using the provided garbage disposal units.

Access and Identity

- It is required to always have a valid college ID or physical event passes, which should be produced upon request.
- The pass is non-transferable and non-refundable. Any attempts to unfairly share this pass or QR will be punishable.

Dress Code

- Participants are expected to dress in a decent, respectful, and appropriate manner, abiding by the college dress code.
- Clothing that is considered offensive, revealing, or has derogatory language, or imagery is strictly prohibited.
- For competitions and performances, outfits must be event-appropriate and should not go against the student dress code.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to deny entry or request a change of attire if the dress code is violated, especially during pro shows such as concerts and DJ nights.

Security and Safety

- The organisers or security staff must be notified immediately of suspicious activity, medical emergency, or safety risk.
- Police, bouncers and guards are always available. Help desks are located all over the campus.
- SRM University's emergency procedures must be followed without fail.

Corrective Measures

- Teams or individuals who violate this code of conduct may be subject to disciplinary action by the organising committee.
- Warnings, disqualification, expulsion from the campus, or notification of the participant's institution are some examples of actions that will be taken if the code of conduct is violated.
