

# Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy explains how MILAN deals with information when you browse, register, or otherwise interact with the MILAN website. By choosing to use the site, you are stepping into a set of agreed terms, whether or not you stop to read them in full. It is therefore reasonable to pause and ask what kind of information is involved, how it moves through the system, and for what purpose it is ultimately used.

When you sign up for an event, submit a form, or reach out to us directly, you may be asked to share basic personal details. This usually includes things like your name, email address, phone number, college or university affiliation, event registration information, and payment references or transaction IDs. Nothing here is taken without your involvement. You provide this information consciously, often because you want to register, ask a question, or stay informed. The site also automatically collects some background information, like your IP address, browser type, device details, the pages you visit, and how long you stay on them. This information doesn't tell us who you are, but it does help us figure out how the site is being used and how we can make it better.

The data gathered is only utilized for MILAN administration and operation. This entails managing registrations for events, verifying attendance, providing updates, responding to inquiries, and maintaining accurate internal documentation. You always have the option to share personal information. That said, certain features of the website simply will not work without it, such as registering for an event. Importantly, the data is not repurposed for anything unrelated to MILAN's operations. Personal information is not sold, rented, or traded.

We use administrative checks and technical protections to make it less likely that data will be accessed or handled incorrectly. Things like limited permissions and basic security controls do a lot of work behind the scenes. However, pretending that anything online is perfectly secure would be dishonest. Data moves across networks that are not entirely predictable, and there is always some residual risk, even when care is taken. While care is taken, absolute protection cannot be promised.

Information is kept only for as long as it serves a clear purpose. In most cases, this means for the duration of the event and any related administrative work that follows. Once the data is no longer needed, it is either deleted or anonymized.

The MILAN website is meant for individuals who are 18 years of age or older. We do not intentionally collect information from minors. If such data comes to light, it is removed as quickly as possible.

This policy may occasionally be updated to take into account modifications to the law or MILAN's operational procedures. Any updates will be shown on this page. Continued use of the website following such changes indicates acceptance of the amended terms.
